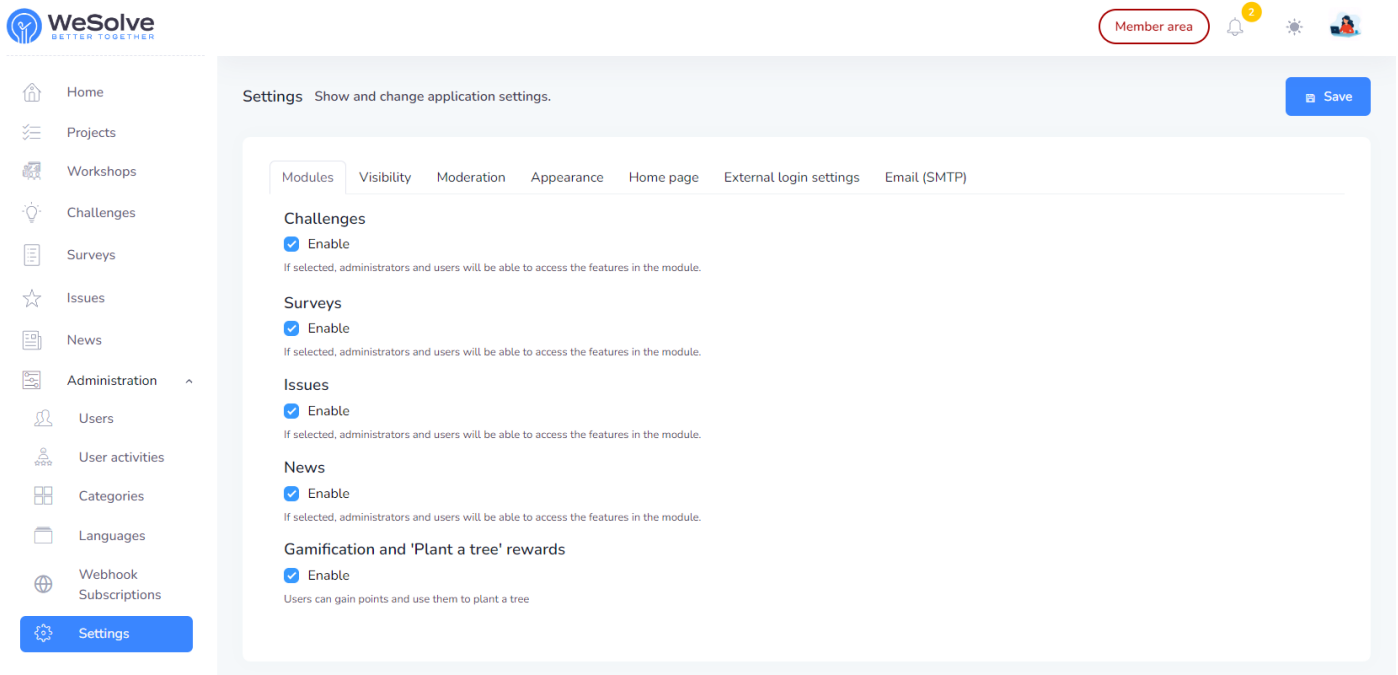
# Enabling or disabling modules

To tailor the platform to better fit the needs of your organization, you can enable or disable specific modules based on their relevance and usage. This customization ensures that only the necessary features are accessible to administrators and users, simplifying the interface and enhancing user experience. Below are the options available for customization:

## How to Customize

1. **Access the Administration Panel:** Log in with your administrator credentials.

## Challenges
